What it is	The Rhode Island Business Competition is an annual competition sponsored by businesses, professional services firms, investors, banks, nonprofits, foundations, colleges, universities, and government agencies.
Legal status	The Competition is a nonprofit 501(c)(3) organization, which was incorporated in Rhode Island in 2005. Name changed in July 2018 from Rhode Island Business Plan Competition to Rhode Island Business Competition.
Goal	The Competition seeks to promote entrepreneurship and the development of start-up and early stage companies in Rhode Island.
Who can participate	Participation is available as follows:
	 Entrepreneur Track — Open to anyone, 18 or older, who is not a full-time student, who is either an entrepreneur or aspires to become one Student Track — Open to full-time undergraduate or graduate students, 18 or older, enrolled in an accredited college or university MedTech/Life Sciences Award — Chosen from all applicants
History	 The Rhode Island Business Competition was established in 2000 with the first prizes awarded in Spring 2001. No competitions were held 2003-2005 due to lack of funding. The Competition was re-established in the fall of 2005, and held annually since. The 2018 Competition was supported by 58 sponsors.
